2024 NHL PLAYOFF POOL RULES



OVERVIEW

- The objective of **2024 NHL Playoff Pool** is to accumulate the most points based on the NHL Playoff Pool Scoring System. Points are accumulated during the 2024 NHL Stanley Cup Playoffs.
- Officepools.com stats website will be utilized with all participants receiving a pool invite upon payment of entry fee.

ROSTER SELECTION (ACTIVE/RESERVE)

- Participants select a total of 20 players consisting of skaters only (forwards and defenseman) with a 16 player Active Roster and a 4 Player Reserve Roster. There are no restrictions on the number of players per position.
- Selections are made via a 'Playoff Pool Draft List' that includes all eligible NHL Players with approximately 70 top performing players that will requiring 'Draft Dollars' to be utilized to be selected. "Draft Dollar' values for the top performing players will be between \$4 to \$1 based on regular season performance.
- The list will also include all remaining eligible players for selection that will require no (\$0) 'Draft Dollars' to be selected.
- Each participant will have 20 'Draft Dollars' to be utilized for the Active Roster and 6 'Draft Dollars' to be utilized for the Reserve Rosters.
- Participants must submit the 'Excel' Playoff Pool Roster form to the commissioner and enter the identical roster in Officepools by **April 20, 2024** @ **12:00 PM EST**. If the roster deadline is missed your entry fee will be forfeited without refund.

RESERVE TRANSACTIONS

- Participants will utilize Officepools.com for Reserve Roster activation requests between playoff rounds.
- Reserve transactions can occur with players from any position.
- Draft Dollar amounts DO NOT apply to transactions once the playoffs begin.
- Transaction requests only occur between rounds when the active player being sent to the Reserve has completed the playoff series and the Reserve players NHL teams plays its next playoff game of the following round.
- When transactions occur, the points accumulated by the player being sent to the reserve will remain for that roster position and the activated players points will then count from that point forward.

SCORING

- The accumulated points of the 16-player Active roster positions during the 2023 NHL Playoffs determine the
 participants total points.
- Points will be awarded for Goals, Assists, Game Winning Goals and Overtime Goals as listed below:

Key G – Goal

A – Assist

Skaters	G	Α	GWG	ОТ
Forwards/Defense	1	1	1*	1*

GWG – Game Winning Goal OT – Overtime Goal

Note * - GWG in Regulation = 2 total points for the player GWG in Overtime = 3 total points for the player.

- The participant with the most points at the completion of the 2023 Stanley Cup Playoffs will be deemed the winner. If participants are tied with equal number of points the following tie breaker will be utilized:
 - 1. Most Goals of all 16 positions on the Active Roster
 - 2. Most Game Winning Goals of all 16 positions on the Active Roster
 - 3. Most Overtime Goals of all 16 positions on the Active Roster
 - 4. If still tied participants will split the prize pool equally.

ENTRY FEE, WINNER & PRIZE POOL

Fee is \$20 US (with additional fee for PayPal payment). Only <u>one entry allowed per person</u>. Participant with most points upon completion of 2024 NHL Stanley Cup Playoffs using scoring system above will be the winner.

PRIZE POOL DISTRIBUTION

*Entire prize pool will be for first place winner UNLESS there are more than 25 participants in which a second-place prize pool will be created.

25 Participants or less: 1st Place 100% of prize pool

26 Participants or more: 1st Place 85% of prize pool, 2nd Place 15% of prize pool.
